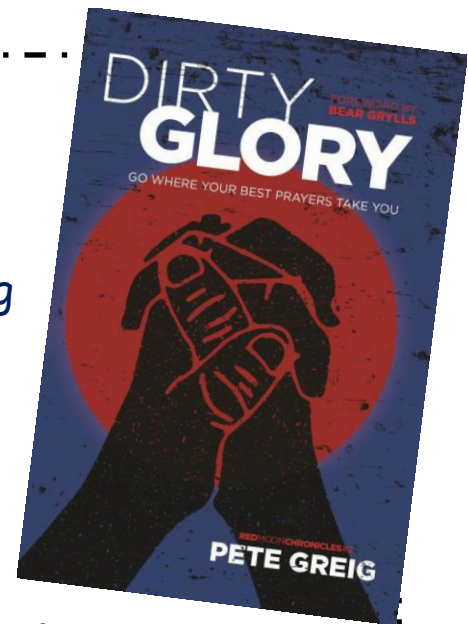
Wed 18th Oct 7pm: **Confirmation Service** at St Michael and All Angels, Melksham
