2. Read **John 10:1-18**. What stands out for you in this passage? When have you experienced Jesus as your shepherd?
3. In the service, we re-wrote **Psalm 23** as 'The Lord's my Skipper' changing the analogy from shepherding to sailing. As a group, have a go at re-writing this Psalm, using imagery from another walk of life. E.g. 'The Lord's my Teacher/Doctor/Engineer' etc.
4. In Sunday's service, we also heard about the Broads Adventure 2024 and New Wine. Why do you think Christian holidays and conferences so valuable, for young people and adults?
